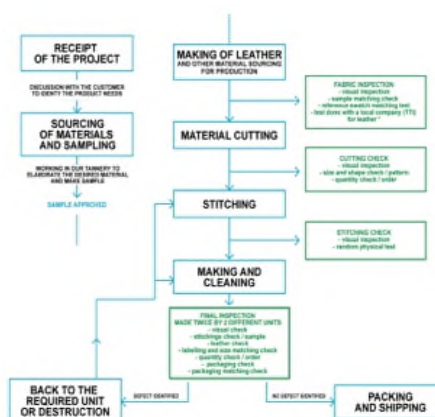
PPE subject to ageing :

Before use, the glove shall be visually controlled, in case of deterioration the gloves must be scrapped (abrasion, cut, tear, ...).

* Physical tests: leather density and thickness tests and tear strength tests according to EN ISO 1317-1:2011.
Chemical tests (pH - ISO 10545 / Chroma 6 - ISO 11075 / Azo - ISO 17326).
We proceed to these tests for each production process, once leather is sourced and before the cutting process.
